

Tasks from District Task Team Meeting 5 July 2008

1. Legal work

- 1.1 Finding out more about the "UNHCR" tickets and Home Affairs registration process due to start this week.
- 1.2 Assisting people who have lost documents apply for replacements (**volunteers needed**).
- 1.3 Consider viability of court case discussed previously.
- 1.4 Consider if legal action can help with problems accessing sites. Especially Chrysalis.

2. Communication with the "JOC" (implementing arm of Government's disaster management): Meet again with aim of improving communication so requests can be actioned by Government.

3. Improve information dissemination to people who are displaced.

4. Need to find people for each health district who are willing to liaise with Sub District Health managers to ensure health issues that arise are remedied by Government. (**volunteers needed**).

5. Press conference on current situation

Other tasks:

2. TAC to start health education. Talk with Mamelani about this.
3. Displaced people, district committees and site assessors to meet.
4. Need to focus on volunteer management
